
The C15TA Armoured Truck was developed by GM Canada along a concept lines of the American M3 Scout Car. The vehicle used the chassis of the Chevrolet C15A Canadian Military Pattern truck design. Between 1943 and 1945 a total of 3,961 units were built in Oshawa, Ontario. Armoured hulls were supplied by the Hamilton Bridge Company


The C15TA was used by the British and Canadian units in the Northwest Europe campaign as armoured personnel carrier and ambulance. After the end of the hostilities, many vehicles were left in Europe and were subsequently employed by armies of the liberated European countries, including Belgium, Denmark, the Netherlands, Norway. In addition about 150 were sold by Canada to Spain. Trucks left by the British forces in Vietnam were taken over by the French, which used them in Indochina and later transferred to South Vietnam. Many C15TAs were employed by the police forces of the Federation of Malaya. In 1955 Portugal received a number of vehicles, which were later used in the African wars. Some vehicles remained in service until the 1960s.







If you are going to use also LZ Models detailing set for this build, check out its assembly instruction first - many parts will be much easier to assemble during your work, especially "Glass windows assembly" and some other interior details will be better to glue in before you complete whole body together














This kit contains additional plastic parts to replace originally used resin ones - also some plastic parts on this sprue can replace parts from sprue A - these are newly tooled, without ejector marks, with molded on hinges










Go through assembly guide before you start your work Extended Assembly guide and part list to download at www.Mirror-models.com **B5** Heat up PE parts with lighter before use, brass will soften and become easy to bend and work with Tamiya Super Thin Glue recommended **B7 B8** for plastic parts В4 b10 x4 back pins on crossbeams into holes in frame sides **B8 B6** B9x 4 front C15 frame assembly PE 25x4 PE30x8 0,5mm dia wire **PE02 B12** rear ends of springs with half C6 round top C10 only angle C3+C4 Set angle between front springs according to angle between front holders B9 before you glue springs on C1+C2, check before glue dries... Make clamps with 0,5mm wire and then glue both differentials














Shock absorbers in the kit are meant rather optional for additional details, PE parts are tiny a require some patience (PE33-35 can be also replaced by simple piece of 0,3mm dia wire for easier handling)



















The kit offers option of closed or open front windows, but because of difference between wall thickness in real and scale, it is only possible with a little surgery. If you want to build closed vehicle without interior details, you can leave these steps






bend base of PE14 180° below to adjust its high for closed window option

cut it out like in picture and use just part with rivets to make hinges for open window option






small windows assembly - for closed option use PE54, for open option use PE53 mind position of PE52, different for opened (down) and closed (up) window





Use these parts from newly tooled sprues - they have hinges molded on




glue front A3 in position - pins to holes in sides, use more thing glue to soften plastic and then with sharp tweezers create in softened plastic nice welding lines. You might also prefer to glue pedals PE 65 on A3 before it is glued between body sides. You can also drill hole 1mm between pedals for steering wheel's rod









Assemble dog house and steering wheel





A31 can be replaced by PE cover from small PE sheet with hinges



Making the door hinges in this kit. There are two option to make hinges, we have retooled most of parts with hinges molded except the body parts.

Now there are two possibilities - in bag are included two clear plastic rods C4-1, C4-2, which can be sliced to single bits, and these glued on sides of middle hinge molded on doors and windows. More effort will need making the hinges of PE bits and wire provided, but it will create the best result.











put wire through hole in PE10, leaving short end at the back, that can be glued into a hole drilled in place where mirrors are to be assembled later - your mirrors will never fall off


















