
Track assembly, 78 links per track, tractors had trouble with falling tracks often, some references mentioned that a tracks were sometimes shortened to 77 links to improve this issue





Russian tractors were painted in Russian green, no further marking shown in photos, just one source mentioned Russian Red Star on the front hull.

Captured tractors in German service had mostly original Russian paint, some sources mention tractors painted in Panzer Grey


Finnish service tractors were painted in dark green, often in combination with lighter green










Mod.1937 in German service
